ORDINANCE NO. 001-185

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY AND INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF TEAMSTERS LOCAL 726

WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Transit Authority Act (70 ILCS 3605/28a) provides that the Chicago Transit Board has the right to deal with and enter into Collective Bargaining Agreements with employees represented by a labor organization; and

WHEREAS, International Brotherhood of Teamsters Local 726 is the bargaining agent for the Authority's non-revenue vehicle operators employees; and

WHEREAS, The Authority and International Brotherhood of Teamsters Local 726 have reached agreement on the terms of a new Collective Bargaining Agreement (also known as the Wage and Working Conditions Agreement) which will expire on December 31, 2003; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. That the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board or her designee is hereby authorized to execute the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Chicago Transit Authority and International Brotherhood of Teamsters Local 726, with an expiration date of December 31, 2003. Said Collective Bargaining Agreement shall reflect the terms of the October 10, 2001 tentative agreement, as amended on October 19, 2001, between the parties and as attached hereto.

SECTION 2. That the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board and/or the President of the Chicago Transit Authority, or their designee, shall be authorized to apply such terms of the above-referenced Collective Bargaining Agreement as they deem appropriate to non-bargained for employees of the Chicago Transit Authority.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
