

# Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95<sup>th</sup> Street Terminal to 130<sup>th</sup> Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103<sup>rd</sup>, 111<sup>th</sup>, Michigan (near 116<sup>th</sup>) and 130<sup>th</sup> streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

## 3-HOUR STREET CLOSURE

**Dates:** Wednesday, June 3, 2026

**Locations:** E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street from S. Indiana Avenue to the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) tracks

**Work Hours:** 9am to 12pm

**Work Activity:** Construction Equipment Relocation

**Local Impact:**

- **E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed from S. Indiana Avenue to the UPRR tracks**
- Flagger assistance will be on site to guide traffic around the street closure.
- **The north sidewalk on E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed from 140 E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street to the UPRR tracks.**
- **The south sidewalk on E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street will be closed from 151 to 155 E. 116<sup>th</sup> Street.**
- All closures will be removed immediately once the relocation has been completed.
- There will be noise while the work is being performed. Noise will include:
  - General construction noise
  - Beeping from backup alarms on construction equipment and vehicles
  - Flagging horns
