

Construction Activity Notice

We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

PERMANENT CLOSURES

Effective Date: Wednesday, June 3, 2026

Locations: W. 109th Street to W. 108th Street, from S. Princeton Avenue to the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) tracks

Work Hours: 7am to 5pm (Crews on-site)
Closure Duration: Permanent, continuous 24/7

Work Activity: Permanent Street, Sidewalk, & Alley Closures

Local Impact: **Alleyways:**

- The north-south alley east of the UPRR tracks will be permanently closed from W. 109th Street to W. 108th Street.
- The east-west alley between 350 W. 109th Street & 351 W. 108th Place to the UPRR tracks will be permanently closed.
- The east-west alley between 348 W. 108th Place to 351 W 108th Street to the UPRR tracks will be permanently closed.
- Temporary alleys will be installed at 348 W. 109th Street, 348 & 349 W. 108th Place, and 348 W. 108th Street prior to construction.

Roadways & Sidewalks:

- W. 108th Place will be permanently closed from 352 W. 108th Place to the UPRR tracks.
- The north sidewalk on W. 108th Place will be permanently closed from 348 W. 108th Place to the UPRR tracks.
- The south sidewalk on W. 108th Place will be permanently closed from 349 W. 108th Place to the UPRR tracks.
