We are performing work in preparation for extending the Red Line by 5.5 miles from the 95th Street Terminal to 130th Street. The Red Line Extension also includes building four new Red Line stations at 103rd, 111th, Michigan (near 116th) and 130th streets. To build the project, work will be performed that may affect your community. While progress sometimes comes with inconveniences, we will do our best to keep them to a minimum.

Locations:

- W. 113th Street & S. Yale Avenue
- W. 113th Street & S. Princeton Avenue
- W. 113th Street to the Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) tracks

Work Hours: 7am to 5pm (Crews on-site)
Closure Duration: Permanent, continuous 24/7

Work Activity: Permanent Street, Sidewalk, & Alley Closures

Local Impact: **W. 113th Street & S. Yale Avenue**

- S. Yale Avenue, including the east sidewalk, will be permanently closed from 11343 S. Yale Avenue to the UPRR tracks.
- The west sidewalk on S. Yale Avenue will be permanently closed from 11334 S. Yale Avenue to the Union Pacific UPRR tracks.
- The alley behind 11326 S. Yale Avenue to the UPRR tracks will be permanently closed.

W. 113th Street & Princeton Avenue

- S. Princeton Avenue, including the east sidewalk, will be permanently closed from 11313 S. Princeton Avenue to the UPRR tracks.
- The alley behind 11327 S. Princeton Avenue to the UPRR tracks will be permanently closed.
- The alley adjacent to 11332 S. Princeton Avenue to the UPRR tracks will be permanently closed.
- All garbage and recycling pickup will be coordinated with Streets & Sanitation.

W. 113th Street

- W. 113th Street, including the north and south sidewalks, will be permanently closed from 309 W. 113th Street to the UPRR tracks.
