## NOTICE OF CHANGED FORMAT OF MEETING OF COMMITTEE ON FINANCE AUDIT & BUDGET AND TRANSIT BOARD MEETING SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST 11, 2021 DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC

August 4, 2021

On July 23, 2021, Governor J.B. Pritzker renewed for a period of 30 days the State-wide disaster declaration as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Pursuant to Section 7(e) of the Open Meetings Act, the head of the Chicago Transit Authority has determined that it is not practical or prudent to conduct an in-person meeting in light of the ongoing disaster. This means that as permitted by this section of the Open Meetings Act, there will not be any in-person public meetings, and the Chicago Transit Authority public meetings on August 11, 2021 will take place **only virtually.** 

Because the Governor's Disaster Proclamation remains in effect in the State of Illinois, the meetings on August 11, 2021 are being held electronically or virtually pursuant to the amended provision of the Open Meetings Act, (Section 7(e)), which allows for virtual public meetings while the disaster proclamation remains in effect.

You are encouraged to monitor virtual proceedings of the August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021, Finance, Audit & Budget, and Transit Board Meetings, which will be live streamed and can be found at <a href="https://www.youtube.com/user/CTAConnections">https://www.youtube.com/user/CTAConnections</a> commencing with Committee on Finance, Audit & Budget at 9:30 a.m. and immediately following the Transit Board at 10:00 a.m. If you are unable to monitor the video recording proceedings, a written transcript will be available by Friday, August 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

If you are interested in providing public comment at the Board meeting, you must contact the Office of the Secretary of the Board at the information provided below no later than 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021. It is strongly encouraged that you submit any public comment in writing for the August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Transit Board meeting, and your comment will be read at the Board meeting. Alternatively, you will be provided with phone instructions when you sign up for public comment.
