## NOTICE OF CHANGED FORMAT OF SPECIAL TRANSIT BOARD MEETING SCHEDULED FOR FEBRUARY 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022 DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC

February 11, 2022

There is currently in effect a State-wide disaster declaration as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic which has been renewed from month to month since the start of the pandemic. Pursuant to Section 7(e) of the Open Meetings Act, the head of the Chicago Transit Authority has determined that it is not practical or prudent to conduct an in-person meeting in light of the ongoing disaster. This means that as permitted by this section of the Open Meetings Act, there will not be any in-person public meetings, and the Chicago Transit Authority public meeting on February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022 will take place **only virtually.** 

Because the Governor's Disaster Proclamation remains in effect in the State of Illinois, the meeting on February 18th, 2022 is being held electronically or virtually pursuant to the amended provision of the Open Meetings Act, (Section 7(e)), which allows for virtual public meetings while the disaster proclamation remains in effect.

You are encouraged to monitor virtual proceedings of the February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022, Special Transit Board Meeting, which will be live streamed and can be found at <a href="https://www.youtube.com/user/CTAConnections">https://www.youtube.com/user/CTAConnections</a> commencing with Transit Board at 12:00 p.m. If you are unable to monitor the video recording proceedings, a written transcript will be available by Monday, February 21st, 2022.

If you are interested in providing public comment at the Board meeting, you must contact the Office of the Secretary of the Board at the information provided below no later than 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022. It is strongly encouraged that you submit any public comment in writing for the February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022 Transit Board meeting, and your comment will be read at the Board meeting. Alternatively, you will be provided with phone instructions when you sign up for public comment.
