

ORDINANCE NO. 026-50

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY  
OF LILY DIEGO-JOHNSON AS A  
MEMBER OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT  
BOARD AND APPOINTING HER TO  
THE FINANCE, AUDIT & BUDGET  
COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Lily Diego-Johnson was appointed as a member of the Chicago Transit Board by Mayor Brandon Johnson on April 15, 2026, and the appointment was effective May 1, 2026, for a term expiring September 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Diego-Johnson has taken and subscribed the constitutional oath of office and has filed it in the office of the Illinois Secretary of State, and all other requirements of Section 20 of the Metropolitan Transit Authority Act, 70 ILCS 3605/20, have been met; and

WHEREAS, Section 48.2 of the Bylaws, Rules, and Regulations and Rules of Order of the Chicago Transit Board provides that the Chairman of the Board shall appoint members to Board Committees with the approval of the Transit Board; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD  
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The appointment of Lily Diego-Johnson as a member of the Chicago Transit Board to a term ending September 1, 2026, is hereby made a matter of record upon the permanent files of this Board.

SECTION 2. As of the effective date of appointment, the salary of Lily Diego-Johnson as a member of the Chicago Transit Board is hereby fixed at the rate of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) per annum.

SECTION 3. The Board hereby ratifies the Chairman's appointment of Lily Diego-Johnson as a member of the Committee on Finance, Audit & Budget.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
