

ORDINANCE NO. 026-54

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A
CHANGE ORDER TO A CONTRACT
WITH CUMMINS, INC. FOR NON-
WARRANTY CONTINGENT REPAIRS
OF CUMMINS DIESEL ENGINES

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority (“Authority”) requires non-warranty contingent repairs on Cummins Diesel Engines in the Authority’s bus fleet; and

WHEREAS, On May 25, 2022, the Authority entered into a contract with Cummins, Inc. under Requisition No. B22OP00554 for the required services for thirty-six months in the amount of \$295,000.00, per Ordinance No. 022-40, the contract was extended twelve (12) months by letter, and Change Order No. 1 added \$29,500.00 in funds; and

WHEREAS, Staff requests Change Order No. 2 to extend the contract by an additional six (6) months through November 24, 2026 to ensure the repair services are not interrupted and to provide sufficient time to procure a new contract; and

WHEREAS, Change orders for contracts originally valued at \$1,000,000.00 or less that individually or cumulatively increase the original contract value by more than 10% or extend the original contract completion or termination date by more than twelve months require approval by the Transit Board; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends approval of Change Order No. 2 to the contract with Cummins, Inc. for non-warranty contingent repairs on Cummins Diesel Engines in the Authority’s bus fleet to extend the contract by an additional six (6) months; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, the President or Acting President of the Authority, and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to execute Change Order No. 2 to the Authority’s contract with Cummins, Inc. for non-warranty contingent repairs on Cummins Diesel Engines in the Authority’s bus fleet to extend the contract by an additional six (6) months through November 24, 2026 with the current cumulative contract amount of Three Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$324,500.00).

SECTION 2. The Chairman, President or Acting President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

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SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
