

ORDINANCE NO. 026-56

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A
CHANGE ORDER TO A CONTRACT
WITH SIEMENS MOBILITY, INC. FOR
FURNISHING AND DELIVERY OF
REPAIR PARTS FOR SIGNAL
EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority (“Authority”) requires furnishing and delivery of repair parts for signal equipment manufactured by Siemens Mobility, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, On May 17, 2024, the Authority entered into a contract with Siemens Mobility, Inc. under Requisition No. B21OP00536R for the required services and materials for thirty-six (36) months for the not-to-exceed amount of \$250,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Usage on the current contract is higher than anticipated due to many items produced by Siemens reaching their end of life expectancy and higher usage of discontinued gate mechanisms that have required more frequent repairs with updated components; and

WHEREAS, Staff requests Change Order No. 1 to add additional funding in the amount of \$125,000.00 to ensure there is no lapse in service while a new contract can be procured; and

WHEREAS, Change orders for contracts originally valued at \$1,000,000.00 or less that individually or cumulatively increase the original contract value by more than 10% require approval by the Transit Board; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends approval of Change Order No. 1 to the contract with Siemens Mobility, Inc. for furnishing and delivery of repair parts for signal equipment to add \$125,000.00 in funds; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, the President or Acting President of the Authority, and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to execute Change Order No. 1 to the Authority’s contract with Siemens Mobility, Inc. for furnishing and delivery of repair parts for signal equipment to add One Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars \$125,000.00 in funds, for a revised contract amount of Three Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$375,000.00).

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SECTION 2. The Chairman, President or Acting President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
