

ORDINANCE NO. 026-61

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING
PUBLIC BIDDING
DISADVANTAGEOUS AND
AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT
FOR MAINTENANCE AND
SUPPORT SERVICES FOR
ORACLE APPLICATION
PRODUCTS AND SOLUTIONS
WITH MYTHICS, LLC

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority (“Authority”) requires maintenance and support services for Oracle products and solutions; and

WHEREAS, The Authority also requires Oracle Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) licenses, including the Hyperion budgeting software currently utilized by Finance and other budgeting departments, inventory management and supply chain software utilized by the Purchasing department, Oracle Business Intelligence software, and in addition to the ERP, Oracle databases are used for other Authority’s mission critical applications; and

WHEREAS, Vendor migration is risky due to the high customization of the Authority’s systems where changing vendors would result in major implementation disruptions and Mythics, LLC is an Oracle partner; and

WHEREAS, This contract will ensure there is no lapse in coverage while Purchasing advertises an RFP to competitively bid for future Oracle maintenance and support services; and

WHEREAS, This procurement was reviewed and approved by the Authority’s Sole Source/Disadvantageous Review Committee (SDRC); and

WHEREAS, Section 1.4D of the Authority’s Procurement Policy and Procedures provides for the award of contracts without competitive bidding, when federal funds are not utilized, for such other matters as the Board determines that competitive bidding is disadvantageous and that advertising for bids would serve no useful purpose and would not be in the best interest of the Authority or the public; and

WHEREAS, A Disadvantageous to Public Bidding contract requires approval by the Transit Board; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends award of a contract to Mythics, LLC under Requisition No. B27OP02021 for maintenance and support services for Oracle products and solutions for up to eighteen months, effective June 1, 2026, in the not-to-exceed amount of \$5,693,718.26; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, the President or Acting President of the Authority, and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Mythics, LLC under Requisition No. B27OP02021 for maintenance and support services for Oracle products and solutions for up to eighteen months, effective June 1, 2026, in the not-to-exceed amount of Five Million Six Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Seven Hundred Eighteen Dollars and Twenty-Six Cents (\$5,693,718.26).

SECTION 3. The Chairman, President or Acting President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
