

ORDINANCE NO. 026-85

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING
PARTIAL FUNDING FOR THE OPTION
TERM CONTRACT WITH HAYDEN AI
TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR
AUTOMATED BUS LANE
ENFORCEMENT (ABLE) CAMERA
SYSTEMS

WHEREAS, in April 2025 and pursuant to Ordinance 25-33, the Chicago Transit Authority ("Authority") entered into a contract with Hayden AI Technologies, Inc. under Requisition No. C24CT103084144 to furnish, deliver, install, and maintain a base order of 6 Automated Bus Lane Enforcement (ABLE) camera systems with operation and maintenance for 24 months with one unfunded option to purchase up to 94 cameras with operations and maintenance for 24 months and a second unfunded option to extend 12 additional months for operation and maintenance for the amount of \$315,852.00; and

WHEREAS, Based on the successful completion of the base order, staff is requesting to partially fund Option One to allow for the purchase of 24 additional cameras, including 24 months of operation and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Staff is requesting additional funds in the amount of \$2,421,532.00 to partially fund this option; and

WHEREAS, Board approval is required pursuant to the Procurement Policy Procedures Section 4.42(H) since the contract amount is increasing by more than 10% of the original contract value; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends approval of additional funding to the contract with Hayden AI Technologies, Inc. to furnish, deliver, install, and maintain a base order of six Automated Bus Lane Enforcement (ABLE) camera systems with operation and maintenance to add \$2,421,532.00 to exercise Option One for the purchase of 24 additional cameras, including 24 months of operation and maintenance; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chicago Transit Board hereby authorizes additional funding in the not-to-exceed amount of Two Million Four Hundred Twenty-One Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Two Dollars (\$2,421,532.00) for Option One partial funding to the contract with Hayden AI Technologies, Inc. to furnish, deliver, install, and maintain a base order of six Automated Bus Lane Enforcement (ABLE) camera systems with operation and maintenance to exercise Option One for the purchase of 24 additional cameras, including 24 months of operation and maintenance, for a revised contract total of Two

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Million Seven Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand Three Hundred Eight-Four Dollars (\$2,737,384.000).

SECTION 2. The Chairman, President or Acting President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
