

ORDINANCE NO. 022-168

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A
CONTRACT WITH OCCUPATIONAL
HEALTH CENTERS OF ILLINOIS,
P.C. D/B/A CONCENTRA MEDICAL
CENTERS FOR PROFESSIONAL
MEDICAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, The Chicago Transit Authority (“Authority”) requires a medical services provider to provide pre-employment and fit-for-duty medical exams, return to work exams, lab testing, and drug and alcohol test collection for its job applicants and employees; and

WHEREAS, The services include reviewing medical documentation provided by the employee and the Authority’s Third-Party Administrator and providing a medical recommendation concerning the employee’s ability to return to work; and

WHEREAS, The provider must have locations within the Authority’s service area sufficient to handle examination requirements during the Authority’s peak recruitment and hiring periods, and the provider must work with the Authority to expedite the testing process while maintaining high-quality, auditable services; and

WHEREAS, The Authority issued a Request for Proposals under Requisition No. B22OP04781 for qualified firms to provide the required services, and Occupational Health Centers of Illinois, P.C. d/b/a Concentra Medical Centers’ proposal was determined to be most advantageous to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends award of a contract to Occupational Health Centers of Illinois, P.C. d/b/a Concentra Medical Centers for background investigation services for three years with two funded one-year options for a not-to-exceed amount of \$6,300,000.00; now, therefore:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CHICAGO TRANSIT BOARD
OF THE CHICAGO TRANSIT AUTHORITY:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board, the President of the Authority, and the Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are hereby authorized to execute a contract with HireRight, LLC for background investigation services for three (3) years with two (2) funded one-year options for a not-to-exceed amount of Six Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$6,300,000.00).

SECTION 2. The Chairman, President, and Vice President of Purchasing and Supply Chain, or their designees, are further authorized to take such actions and execute such documents as may be necessary to implement the objectives of this ordinance.
